授業概要	<p>In this class, we will work on two areas:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. You will continue to focus on activities within the CHieru e-learning system, 2. We will explore English as it is used in such media as the Internet, television, movies, and newspapers. Each week students will be required to research material and present it to the class or their group. Following each presentation, we will discuss the material, so participation in English will be very important. We will also explore the English parts of the World Wide Web to see what is available, particularly for helping you build your English skills. Then, we are going to assemble or create material of our own to publish online. As part of this class, students will need access to the Internet as all class materials will be available there, along with extra study activities. Read, think, present, discuss, listen, argue, collaborate, share... these will all be important skills to use in this class.
