授業概要	<p>This course is a continuation of what was started in the first semester. Once again, we will be using Critical Thinking as the basis for the activities we do in class. In this task-based course, we will be looking at topics that are relevant to your lives, and discussing them using critical thinking skills—in other words, not WHAT to think, but HOW to think. Not only will you be students, but you will also be expected to take on the roles of researchers, designers, presenters, leaders, and even teachers.</p> <p>Within each class, we will examine a current topic from a number of perspectives. We will also look at a specific critical thinking skill, and see how we can apply it to that topic. In preparation for the classes, you will be expected to research material related to the topic, and be prepared to discuss it in English in the class.</p> <p>During the semester, you will once again be working on a personal project. You will present this at the end of the course to show how your skills of critical thinking have developed through the semester.</p>
