Because of the COVID19 pandemic, some classes may be conducted online. For online classes, students will need to have an Internet-capable device and access to the Internet. You will also need to install the Zoom app (freely available). Students will need to access the course page on the "My Study" Moodle to check their Zoom times and access details.
