授業概要	In this course we will learn about key elements of Australian society, history and culture through the lens of race, specifically looking at the topics of multiculturalism and Indigenous Australians. To do this we will use various methods and materials such as official statistics, newspaper articles, movies, music, and other online resources. Important background information will also be presented in a lecture format, with all lectures given in English. Although this course focuses on the region of Australia, students will learn various approaches and methods used in area studies in general, and there will be opportunities to apply this in the final presentation and new portfolio assignment. Students should note that this course will be conducted in English. Various levels and types of language support will be made available as necessary in consultation with students. The class schedule may be slightly altered depending on student progress and specific interests.
