They should show they understand and are able to use the language in the textbook to present their ideas. They should also contribute to the group projects, and complete the homework exercises. Attendance of all classes is also expected.</p>						
理想的レベル	<p>The ideal student will take an active role in expressing their opinions about the topics under discussion. They will make an effort to use the language covered in the textbook, and to extend the basic conversations beyond the examples given. They will be able to clearly and logically present their ideas. They will also contribute to and complete the various projects and homework activities.</p>
