授業概要	<p>In this class, you will focus on two things. The first will be on reading non-fiction quickly with good understanding. You will time yourself as you read very easy passages from the textbook in order to develop the habit of reading without stopping, and to help increase your reading speed.</p> <p>The second thing you will be doing is Extensive Reading. Extensive Reading means reading a lot. When you read many pages of a book or magazine that you enjoy and that is written in easy English, you pick up a lot of new phrases and see a lot of familiar words in new contexts. As a result, your English improves without a lot of conscious study. But you have to spend plenty of time on reading. The extensive reading part of the course will mostly be done as homework. This means you will need to spend time every week reading books outside of class.</p> <p>We will also spend time on planning and assessing your reading goals.</p> <p>We will be using XReading and other online tools to deliver the class content as required.</p> <p>All classes will be taught in English.</p>

標準的レベル	<p>The aim of this course is to help students be able to do the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - I can read more than 150 words per minute at an easy level - I can read phrase by phrase rather than word by word, for total meaning - I can plan my time to spend at least 180 minutes (about 25 minutes per day) per week on out-of-class reading - I can read enough books in English to reach the reading goal of 150,000 words in this semester. <p>Students must do the in-class reading and keep clear records of their reading progress. They need to do regular reading outside of class every week, and record progress with the online quiz system. They need to read the minimum required number of books at a level suitable for</p>						

	their understanding, but at the same time not too simple. They will also need to complete two class projects related to the books being read.										
理想的 レベル	To achieve a high level of performance, students will need to complete the required reading goals (reading 10,000 words or more) for class each week. They will need to take part in the class seriously and actively, and complete the online reading portfolio each week. They will need to regularly complete all in-class activities and keep a record of their reading progress both in class and out.
