授業概要	<p>This course follows up on the skills you learned in リーディング I. In this class, we will be working on understanding and using reading strategies to help improve your reading speed and comprehension. There will also be regular vocabulary learning activities. You will be required to do regular out-of-class reading and planning and assessing your reading goals, as in the first semester.</p> <p>All classes will be taught in English.</p>

学生が達成すべき行動目標							
標準的レベル	<p>The aim of this course is to help students be able to do the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Understand and be able to use a variety of reading strategies - Expand their vocabulary and improve their grammar - Effectively plan their time to spend at least 180 minutes (about 25 minutes per day) per week on out-of-class reading - Read enough books in English to reach a suitable reading goal for the semester. <p>Students must do the in-class reading and vocabulary work, and keep clear records of their reading progress and vocabulary study. They need to do regular reading outside of class every week, and record progress with the online quiz system. They need to read the minimum required number of books at a level suitable for their understanding, but at the same time not too simple. They will also need to complete two class projects related to the books being read.</p>						
理想的レベル	<p>To achieve a high level of performance, students will need to complete the required reading goals (reading 10,00 words or more) for class each week. They will need to take part in the class seriously and actively, and complete the online reading portfolio each week. They will need to regularly complete all in-class activities and keep a record of their reading progress both in class and out.</p>
