Students must do the in-class reading and vocabulary work, and keep clear records of their reading progress and vocabulary study. They need to do regular reading outside of class every week, and record progress with the online quiz system. They need to read the minimum required number of books at a level suitable for their understanding, but at the same time not too simple. They will also need to complete two class projects related to the books being read.

They will need to take part in the class seriously and actively, and complete the online reading portfolio each week.
