Each project will focus on a different form of media, such as:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Digital storytelling • Magazine and newspaper writing • Podcast and blog creation • Using TED Talks • Website creation • The role of influencers • Creating a documentary or TV programme <p>Each project will be graded, with those grades going towards your final grade. Therefore, it is important to complete each assignment. This will be an interesting and creative course for students who apply themselves to each assignment.</p> <p>NOTES:</p> <p>1. All classes will be taught in English.</p>

授業計画											
第1回	1. Course introduction: Information about the course, and an introduction to the website we will be using. Safety and care online. 2. Digital Literacy with A.I. orientation.										
第2回	Project 1: Digital Storytelling 1 Taking original stories from the students' own lives and creating them in digital form using their choice of media.										
第3回	Project 1: Digital Storytelling 2 Completing the digital stories from Week 1 and presenting them to the class, followed by discussion and feedback.										
第4回	Project 2: Magazine Writing 1 Working in groups, create a print-ready magazine on the topic of their choice. This can be done using Pages or Canva.										
第5回	Project 2: Magazine Writing 2 Completing the magazines and sharing them with the class, followed by discussion and feedback.										
第6回	Project 3: Podcasts & Blogs 1 Creating a podcast or blog on a topic of their choice, working alone or in pairs.										
第7回	Project 3: Podcasts & Blogs 2 Completing the podcasts or blogs and sharing them with the class, followed by discussion and feedback.										
第8回	Project 4: TED Talks 1 Introduction to TED Talks: What they are and how to use them for language learning. Finding suitable TED Talks and creating discussion questions or activities.										
第9回	Project 4: TED Talks 2 Watching other students' choices of TED Talks and responding to their questions or activities.										

第10回	Project 5: Website Design 1 After sharing their favorite websites, students will work in groups to design a website on the topic of their choice. This will focus on the user experience, such as accessibility, navigation, and graphic design.
第11回	Project 5: Website Design 2 Completing the website designs and sharing them with the class, followed by discussion and feedback.
第12回	Project 6: Poster Design Looking at what a well-designed poster is and designing a poster for an event using Canva. Sharing designs with other class members and giving feedback.
第13回	Project 7: Documentary or TV Program 1 Students will work in groups to plan, film, edit, and create a documentary or TV program on a topic of their choice.
第14回	Project 7: Documentary or TV Program 2 Continue working on their media with feedback from teacher and other students.
第15回	Project 7: Documentary or TV Program 3 Present videos to the class. Provide feedback to each group. Final course review and evaluation.
テキスト	All materials will be provided by the teacher. Follow-up assignments, quizzes, and journals will be completed on our My Study website.
