標準的レベル	<p>Students who successfully complete this course will be able to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Use the content of the first semester as a basis for all activities</li> <li>- Use simple grammatical expressions they have learned to clearly explain Japanese objects, cultural practices, and concepts covered in both semesters.</li> <li>- Understand and respect cultural differences, while also maintaining a personal set of beliefs based on factual information</li> <li>- Exhibit critical thinking skills in considering more than one perspective at a time</li> <li>- Continue to enjoy using English in a relaxed way while also respecting their classmates and instructor in a positive, collegial learning environment.</li> </ul> <p>Following from semester 1, students must arrive to class on time, and remain awake and engaged with classmates during the 90 minute class period. Students must not interact with any devices (smartphones, etc.) that distract or draw attention away from the class learning objectives. Students must complete all class activities to the best of their abilities. Students must complete all homework in a timely manner and adequately prepare for quizzes and tests in the second semester.</p>
