Each week, we will focus on one topic, and you will talk with other students, ask questions, share ideas, and hold discussions. You will be expected to participate fully in English to get the most out of these classes. In addition, you will need to prepare for your next classes using the material the teacher gives you.</p> <p>Note: All classes will be taught in English.</p>
