授業概要	This course is a continuation of English Communication I which you studied in the first semester. As well as the English you have been studying for many years, you have also had a semester of university English study. As you have learned, studying a language is much more than learning grammar and vocabulary—it is about communicating, which will be the main focus of this course.						
	This course will work on building your speaking and listening skills, plus we will look at some of the culture behind the English language. Each week, we will focus on one topic, and you will talk with other students, ask questions, share ideas, and hold discussions. You will be expected to participate fully in English to get the most out of these classes. In addition, you will need to prepare for your next classes using the material the teacher gives you.
